Firstly I would like to point out that I have not done a briefing for approx 3 weeks. Hence the length of the report.

Much Birch

Between the 31st of October and 4th of November a property in Much Birch had a padlock broken off of a garage and items were stolen from within.

Overnight the 2nd and 3rd a garage door was taken off the rollers by offenders however nothing appears to have been stolen.

Didley and Winnal

On the 7th of November a Gas bottle was stolen from a rural property in Didley. The occupant had a suspicious caller that day in a large new looking white van. The callers had made enquiries regarding the gas bottle.

A property in Winnal had locks cut off the gates between 19:00 on the 21st and 09:00 on the 22nd. Nothing appears to have been stolen from the property.

St Owens Cross

Overnight between the 8th and 9th of November, an outbuilding was broken into at a property in St Owens Cross, a trailer and pressure washer were stolen.

Grafton, Callow and Dinedor

Entry was gained to an outbuilding at a Farm in Grafton. A 25ft air line was stolen from a compressor along with the couplings. This was reported on the 15th of November and happened sometime in the previous month.

Between the 18th and 22nd of November two metal sheds were broken into in the Grafton area. Offenders have attempted to take a metal shooting trap. They were not successful however have damaged the item.

Sometime between 15:00 and 18:00 on the 14th of November a rural outbuilding in the Callow area was entered by offenders and various items were stolen.

Sometime between the 6th and 20th of November approx 650 bails of Hay were stolen from a farms outbuilding in Dinedor. The lock was broken off the entrance when the entry was gained.

Kingstone

Damage was caused to a property near to the church in Kingstone. A window was smashed.

Hoarwithy

Between the 19th and 21st of November a registration plate was stolen off a vehicle in Hoarwithy. The number plate will now be added to our ANPR cameras so that should a vehicle using this reg go through a West Mercia camera site Police will be notified.

Llanwarne and Llandinabo

At 15:00 on the 22nd of November a leaf blower was stolen from a vehicle in Llanwarne. Suspects have approached the property and spoken with persons working at the property before leaving with the item.

Overnight 25th to the 26th a workshop was broken into in Llandinabo. The padlock was forced off before offenders made off with various items. A strimmer, battery charger, drills and an angle grinder were stolen.

Garway

During November a number of bags of walling stone have been stolen from a property in Garway. A silver/blue Peugeot 205 has been seen acting suspiciously in the area. Do you know the details of this vehicle? Please call 101 if you have any information.

Positive Policing:
