# **Fastershire Background**



- Partnership between Herefordshire & Gloucestershire Councils Established 2011
- Conduit for Public funding to overcome market failure to provide superfast broadband
  - Monitor Market Failure
  - Raise Public Funding
  - Invest in Solutions
  - Comply with State Aid
  - Manage Suppliers

# Fastershire Community Grant General Concept



- Community led Fastershire facilitate the procurement & payments
- Nominal Grants to individuals to procure gigabit capable Open Access broadband infrastructure
  - max limit per premise £7,000 in Herefordshire
  - subject to a VFM test & max total project maximum of £500k
- 2 Step Process
  - Dynamic Purchasing System Supplier Qualification
  - Mini-Competitions for each project using a grant portal hosted on Fastershire.com

# **Our Suppliers**



All suppliers working on the Community Broadband Grant Scheme must;

- Provide gigabit-capable Full Fibre / Fibre to the Premise (FTTP) connections
- Be an Open Access Network
- Set a standard wholesale price which applies to any Internet Service Provider (ISP) operating on their network

The Fastershire Community Broadband Grant remains open to any network supplier who wish to join the scheme.




### **Map of Grant Area**

- 42 Yet to submit EOI

#### **How to Submit an EOI**




Only one EOI per property and if you have already completed the EOI form for your property, please do no submit another.

**Step 1:** Visit <u>www.fastershire.com</u>

**Step 2:** Use the address checker, enter your postcode and then select your address

**Step 3:** Complete the EOI form shown and 'submit'



#### **Your Commitment**



This is a community lead scheme and requires active involvement from each property who submits an EOI to join the Allensmore community project.

- Attend the community meetings
- Choose the supplier
- Return the contract agreement as soon as possible
  - Confirm when your property is connected so we can pay the supplier on your behalf
  - Take a service to 18months when the connection is live

# **Long Drives**

- welcome to Stevisher Faster broadband for Herefordshire and Gloucestershire
- > By default the Bid will be costed to bring the service to the curtilage of each property that is part of the project
- ➤ We need to specify a zero cost connection to anyone who is more than 100m from the highway and/or can only be accessed up a long / private drive

#### Information we need from you:

- Who owns the land
- Will they provide a free wayleave
- Are there any conditions e.g. verge only, underground only etc
- How is the existing copper delivered
  - Poles
  - Ducts
  - Directly buried
